94.8% of parents stated their children were happy at St. Columba's.

94.66% of parents stated their child felt safe at St. Columba's.

94.66% of parents stated their child was making good progress at our school.

94.66% of parents stated their child is well looked after at our school.

98.66% of parents feel their children are well taught at St. Columba's.

98.59% of parents feel their child gets the appropriate amount of homework.

90% of parents feel the school makes sure the children are well behaved.

64.28% of parents feel the school deal effectively with bullying.

A further 18.57% don't know –many comments on this were due to not having had to deal with these types of incidences. Comments included:

- Not had this to deal with
- Never had to deal/seen an example of this so can't comment

96% of parents felt the school is well led and managed

86.3% of parents felt that the school responded well to concerns they raised

89.18% of parents felt they received valuable information about their child's progress from the school

90.66% of parents that responded would recommend the school to other parents. 4% of parents don't know and 5.34% parents would not.

Positive Comments

Suggested areas for development

- More frequent written reports would be useful, rather than one end of year report.
- Quicker feedback when I've raised an issue about my child being picked on.
- I am a little concerned about the behaviour of some children, but as this information is second hand from my child, I am not sure how much is just his perception of situations.
- I suggest that at the beginning of every term we have a plan for what the children will be learning that term.
- Only two parents' evenings per year, so I'm not always sure about what progress is being made.

Without exception, all parents who ticked 'strongly disagree' or 'no', left the questionnaire anonymous and did not offer any further comments.

Action

- Amending behaviour and anti-bullying policy (to be finalised by March 2017)
- Implemented new playground rules and routines in agreement with School Council
- Developing use of Young Sports Leaders at lunchtime
- More opportunities to gather feedback from parents, especially concerning issues raised
- End of year expectations to be sent out to all parents prior to parents evening in March 2017. These will be used as the basis for conversations around progress.
