English

This term, in English we will be using the text 'The Scarecrow's Wedding' by Julia Donaldson to build on the basic sentence structure we learned in Autumn I. We will focus on writing simple descriptions and looking types of character. After this we will look at the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will look at the repetition in the book at the different parts of the story. Our outcome at the end of the half term will be to retell a simple narrative. We will use the story of The Three Little Pigs to form our retell.

We will continue to work on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to punctuate our sentences correctly.

Science

We will continue our Science topic 'Everyday Materials' this half term. In this unit we will:

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their physical properties.

Art and Design

This half term we will focus on Art. Our topic will be 'Let's Draw!'

We will be exploring line and shape and will use pencils and pastels as a tool to draw.

We will talk about the work of the artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser and create a piece of art based on his style.

Topic I – Judaism – we will explore the religion of Judaism and learn about key religious figures; Abraham and Moses.

Topic 2 – Advent/Christmas – Loving. Our topic this half term is Waiting. We will be learning about the importance if waiting and how we wait to celebrate Jesus coming at Christmas.

- represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 10, including zero
- solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations

Geometry -recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes.



This half term we will focus on Geography. During our geographical study, we will be working towards answering the question 'What is Geography?'.

We will be learning about what human and physical geography is and what features we can find in our local area, about simple maps and symbols and how to read the four points on a compass.
