This term, in English we will be reading a variety of examples of diaries to support the children in writing their own diaries. They will use past tense, first person, time openers and conjunctions.

They will continue to read a selection of books connected to Refugee Week and analyse the texts through 'Vipers' and 'Fields of White'

The children will use drama techniques such as 'Hot seating' and 'Freeze frame' to support their empathy towards characters.

Science

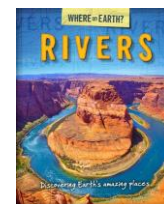
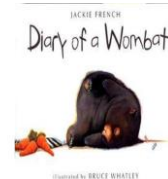
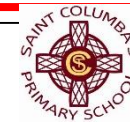
Our Science topic this half term is 'Living things and their habitats'

For this, the children will learn about the needs of living things, how to categorise them using their features. They will know the importance of producers and the role of the predator.

They will understand the importance of the environment and habitat and how the human impact can have a negative impact on the health of living things.

In this geography unit 'Mountains and Rivers' the children locate major mountains and rivers.

They will study the various stages of a river, as it ages, and how that effects the landscape around it. They will be able to identify the physical features of various mountains and understand how the landscape changes with height.
