

English

This half term, in English we will be using the animation 'The Alchemist's Letter' as part of our focus on narrative writing. We will consider:

- using higher order vocabulary
- cohesive skills and descriptive techniques
- semicolons, speech punctuation and relative clauses.

Our outcome at the end of the half term will be to write our own five-part narrative based on the visual text 'The Alchemist's Letter'.

- solve number and practical problems

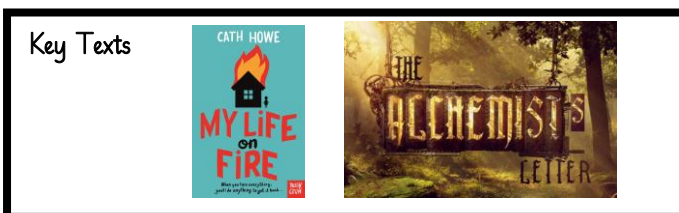
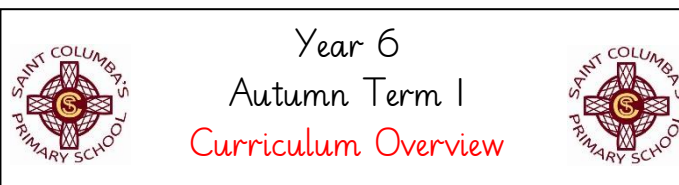
Calculation

- confidently add and subtract large numbers and decimals
- multiply and divide by two digit numbers using formal methods
- factors, multiple and primes
- problem solving

Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Living Things and Their Habitats'. In this unit we will:

- describe how living things are classified into groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals
- give reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics



Geography

Our geography is focussed on fieldwork and covers the following areas:

- Read and understand ordnance survey maps, identifying symbols and using eight-point compass directions.
- Give directions using 4 and 6 digit co-ordinates, understand contour lines and conduct geographical fieldwork.

History

- Our history topic this half term is: How did World War II change Britain. Our focus areas are:
 - Investigate the reasons for the outbreak of war, key events, and key historical figures of WW2.
 - Research reasons and effects of evacuation, the Holocaust and the impact of WW2 on Britain. We will follow lines of enquiry and use a range of sources.
