English

Maths

Number and Place Value to 10

- count to and across 10, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- count, read and write numbers to 10 in numerals;
- given a number, identify one more and one less
- identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations
- read and write numbers from I to 10 in numerals and words.

Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Everyday Materials'. In this unit we will:

- distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their physical properties.
