English

This term, in English we will be using the texts 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson and 'Where the Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak to develop our writing skills. Our topic focus is narrative and characters. We will explore the characters in each story as we go and use our knowledge from what we have read to help up describe them. Our outcome at the end of the half term will be to write a character description.

We will continue to work on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to punctuate our sentences correctly. We will build on our knowledge of nouns, verbs and adjectives by describing the characters from the texts.

Science

Our topic this half term is 'Seasonal Changes'. In this unit we will:

- observe changes across the four seasons
- observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.
- talk about changes in the weather and the seasons.
- work scientifically by: making tables and charts about the weather
