

English

This half term, we will be writing a 5-part narrative focusing on setting and character description based upon the book 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief' by Rick Riordan. To do this we will:

- make use of expanded noun phrases to enhance our descriptions
- use subordinate clauses, relative clauses and a variety of punctuation
- write in third person and edit and improve our work

We will also be writing a persuasive brochure based upon 'Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief.' To do this we will:

- use persuasive devices such as rhetorical questions and hyperbole
- include the features of a brochure
- use relative clauses and parenthesis for extra information

Area and Perimeter

Statistics

- Draw, read and interpret line graphs
- Read and interpret tables, including two way tables.

Shape
