This term, in English, we will be studying the works of Anthony Browne.

Reading 'The Stolen Spear' as a class novel and 'It Fell from the Sky'

-Explore the grammar and vocabulary required for a narrative

-understand the use of commas, exclamation marks and speech.

We will use 'The Lighthouse' as a stimulus for writing character descriptions using adjectives and strong verbs.

In non-fiction writing we will use 'The First Drawing' by Mordicai Gerstein to discuss the conventions of speech.

Maths

Number and Place Value

- read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1000
- partition numbers to 1000
- finding 'more' or 'less' and estimating

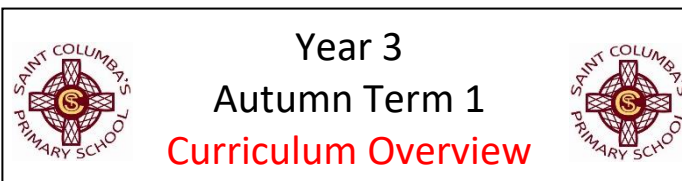
Calculation

- confidently add and subtract large numbers up to 100

Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Rocks'

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived trapped within the rock
- Recognise that soils are made from organic

In History, we will be learning about how Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age

- explain what prehistoric means and use the vocabulary
- Describe and explore daily life and beliefs
- know how evidence from the past is studied

Art through the ages and colour mixing

-Learn about different styles of painting across the ages

-Know primary colours and learn to mix them to make secondary colours

-Use different brush strokes for effect

- create my own painting using my colours and strokes
