## **English**

This term, in English, we will be studying the works of Anthony Browne. Reading 'The Stolen Spear' as a class novel and 'It Fell from the Sky'

- -Explore the grammar and vocabulary required for a narrative
- -understand the use of commas, exclamation marks and speech.

We will use 'The Lighthouse' as a stimulus for writing character descriptions using adjectives and strong verbs.

In non-fiction writing we will use 'The First Drawing' by Mordicai Gerstein to discuss he conventions of speech.
