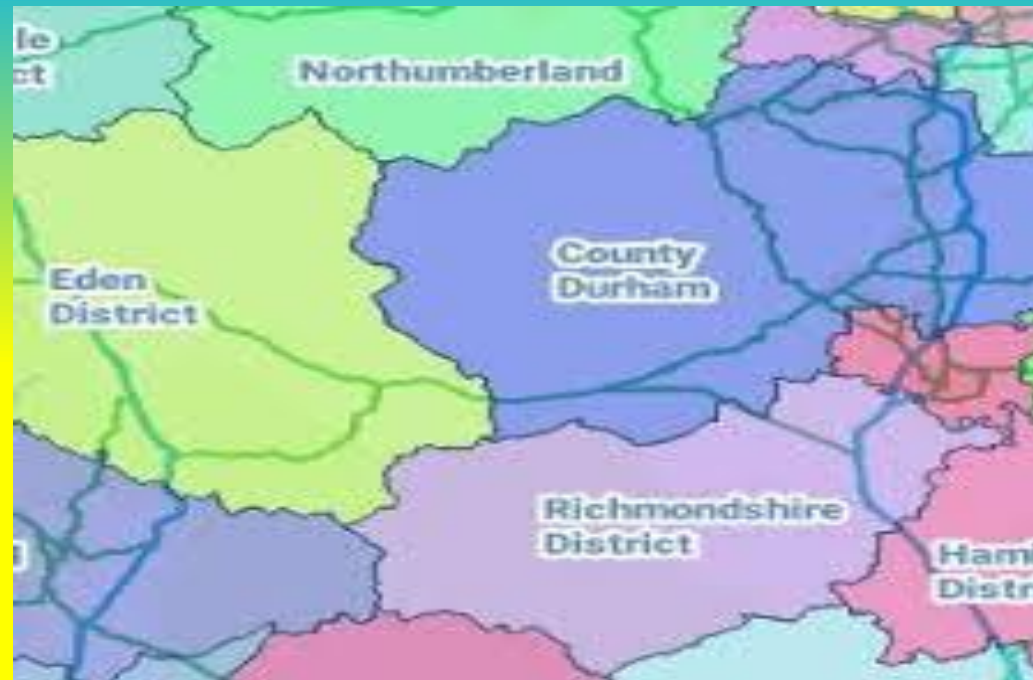


Location

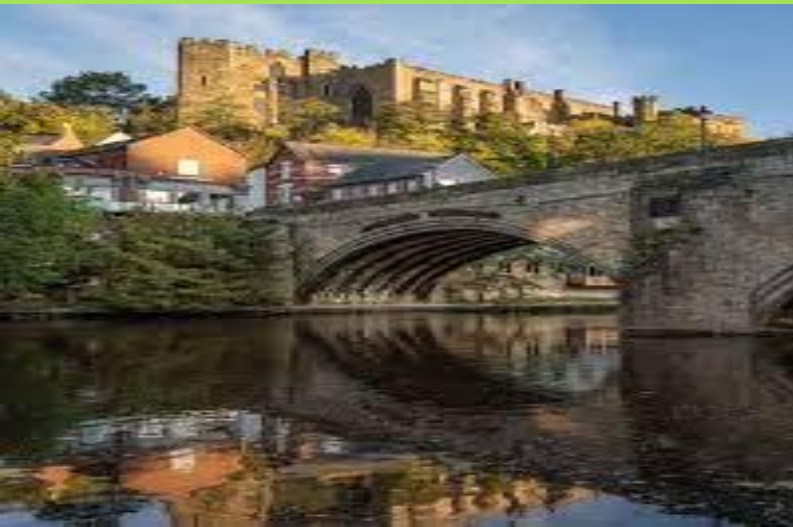
Seaham
