






Spennymoor is a town and [civil parish](#) in [County Durham](#), England. It stands above the [Wear Valley](#) about 7 mi (11 km) south of [Durham](#).

The land on which Spennymoor now stands was once a vast expanse of moorland covered with thorn and whin bushes (Spenny Moor). In 1336 its [place-name](#) was recorded as *Spendingmor*. The name is probably derived from

Seaham is a seaside town in County Durham, England. Located on the Durham Coast, Seaham is situated 6 miles (10 kilometres) south of Sunderland and 13 miles (21 km) east of Durham. The town grew from the late 19th century onwards as a result of investments in its harbour and coal mines. The town is twinned with the German town of Gerlingen.

The original village of Seaham has all but vanished; it lay between St Mary's Church and [Seaham Hall](#) (i.e. somewhat to the north of the current town centre).^[3] The parish church, St Mary the Virgin, has a late 7th century [Anglo Saxon nave](#) resembling the [church at Escomb](#) in many respects,^[4] and is one of the 20 oldest surviving churches in the UK.
