

## English

This half term, in English we will be using the texts 'Herman's Holiday' by Tom Percival and 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Drew Daywalt to write postcards and letters.

- composing sentences orally before writing it
- Oral practise of present, past and future tense
- using correct endings for tense -ing / -ed
- re-reading for sense and punctuation: capital letters and full stops
- nouns and verbs

Our outcome at the end of the half term will be to write our own letter as one of the crayons to Duncan, based on our class text.

- Represent a 2-digit number with tens and ones
- Order numbers to 100

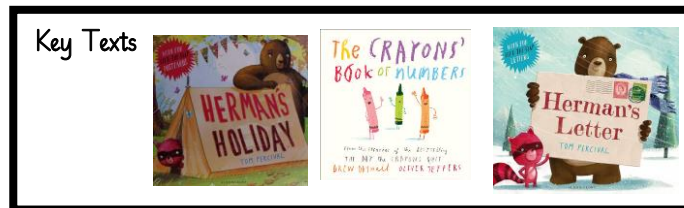
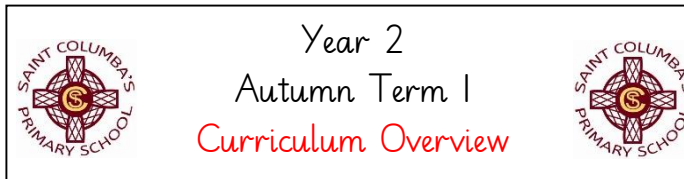
Calculation

- Bonds to 100 (tens)
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s

## Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Animals, including humans.'

- animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults
- recognise growth in animals – butterfly lifecycle
- humans are animals and grow from babies to adults
- basic needs of animals for survival
- basic needs of humans – importance of exercise, balanced diet and hygiene



## Humanities

Our history topic this half term is: How has transport changed? Our focus areas are:

- Investigate whether transport has always been the same.
- Who is George Stephenson?
- How did trains change people's lives?
- How have cars changed since they were invented?
- Who were the Wright brothers and what did they invent?
- Will transport continue to change? Imagining the future

## Design and Technology

Our topic is 'Let's take a ride!'

- exploring mechanism of wheel and axle.
- design own wheeled locomotive
- choose tools and materials.
- exploring cuboid nets, scoring and folding techniques
- create main structure for body and chassis for wheels and axles.
- complete own creation from personal design and paint to finish.
- Test and evaluate.
