

English

This term, we will be using the text 'Holes' by Louis Sachar to write character descriptions, setting descriptions and write a narrative. We will do this by:

- Learning, implementing and sustaining new and impactful vocabulary
- Use descriptive techniques, such as expanded noun phrases, with effect
- Prepositional phrases, adverbs, relative clauses, writing in the first and third person, punctuating speech

Our outcome at the end of the half term will be to write our own three-part narrative based on a short clip from Holes the Movie.

Addition and Subtraction

- confidently add and subtract whole numbers with more than four digits
- rounding, inverse operations, comparison and identifying missing numbers
- problem solving, including multi-step problems

Our Science topic this half term is 'Properties and Changes of Materials'. In this unit we will:

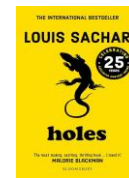
- Carry out lots of experiments to investigate properties and changes of materials and changes of state, with a focus on working safely and scientifically
