- Learning multiplication tables up to 12 x 12

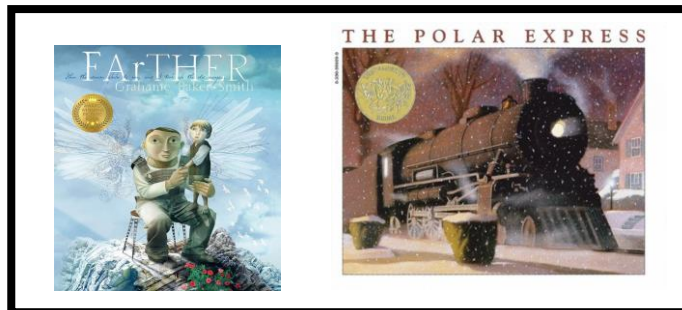
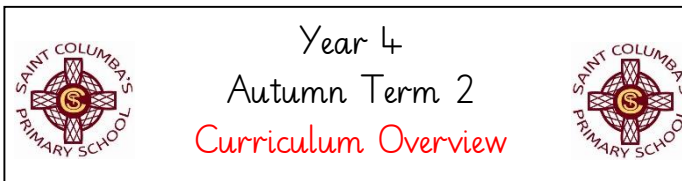
Science
